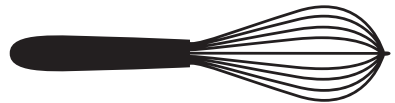

- Entries will be displayed over the Festival weekend in the Snape Maltings House & Garden Shop. Loaves can be collected on Sunday 4.00pm – 5.00pm, or 10.00am – 11.00am on Monday 1 October
- The judges' decision is final.
